RESOLUTION RECOMMENDING, BY REFERENDUM, SECTION 53.9 SMALL VALUE PROCUREMENT OF GOODS AND SERVICES – CONTRACTING OF SHIPPING CONSIGNMENT SERVICES FOR REVERSE LOGISTICS OF 2019 AND PREVIOUS YEARS' ELECTION MATERIALS

WHEREAS, there is a need for procurement for contracting of services and shipment of Election Paraphernalia from 2019 and from previous election years in connection with Posts' Purchase Requests and Approved Budgets for the Contract (ABCs) as well as the amendments for Requests for the Reverse Logistics of the 2019 and previous years' election materials and paraphernalia from Philippine Embassy in Cairo Egypt to Commission on Elections (COMELEC) through DFA-OVS (end to end).;

WHEREAS, further, Section 53.9 of the revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act of 2003", allows an agency to resort to Small Value Procurement of Goods and Services- Reverse Logistics of the 2019 and previous years' election materials and paraphernalia;

WHEREAS, Section 53.9 of said IRR allows an agency to resort to Small Value Procurement where the procurement involves goods and services, provided that the amount involved does not exceed the threshold amount of One Million Pesos (PhP1, 000,000.00); provided further, that the procuring entity shall draw up a list of at least (3) suppliers/service providers that will be invited to submit proposals and directly negotiate a contract with a technically, legally and financial capable supplier;

WHEREAS, the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) of Cairo PE checked on-line quotations from three for courier and packaging services for the reverse logistics of election equipment and materials used in the 2019 and past elections to COMELEC(3) firms, namely: FEDEX, in the amount of 37,215.50 USD; UPS, in the amount of 19,920.38 USD and **MOVEX**, who submitted the lowest calculated amount of 3,825 USD , chargeable against COMELEC, including taxes and other lawful charges;

NOW, THEREFORE, we, the members of the BAC-Cairo PE, RESOLVE to RECOMMEND to the Head of Procuring Entity (HOPE) the resort to Small Value Procurement of Reverse Logistics of the 2019 and previous years' election materials and paraphernalia from Philippine Embassy in Cairo Egypt to Commission on Elections (COMELEC) through DFA-OVS (end to end) from **MOVEX**, subject to the above-mentioned requirements and provided that existing auditing rules and regulations shall be strictly observed by the end-user;

ADOPTED, this 22nd day of November 2021 in Cairo, Egypt.
